

36°N, UMA Tulsa, and Tulsa Tech launched and graduated the first cohort of the *Hispanic Entrepreneurs' Academy*, a 10-week business bootcamp entirely in Spanish.



The **36°N Team** doubled in size to support the growing number of members across our 3 locations.



36°N joined the *Global Accelerator*Network (GAN) and became a founding partner of GAN Hubs, which gives founders access to over \$1M in startup perks and discounts.

Accelerated Spanish

Accelerated Spanish, a revolutionary Spanish fluency program, grew its team to 16 people across 8 countries, teaching over 3,000 students and earning over \$1M in the last 2 years.



Build in Tulsa launched *Female Founders Pitch Night*, a quarterly event awarding winners with startup resources and membership to 36°N.



36°N partnered with Greenwood Cultural Center to launch *Black Gold*, a speaker series hosted by local black entrepreneurs detailing their stories and the stories of those who built Historic Black Wall Street.

Tulsa Remote welcomed over 850 remote workers and entrepreneurs to Tulsa, bringing diverse, bright, and driven individuals to our city to build community, collaborate, and network.

In September, **36°N** opened one of the largest state-certified tech incubators in Oklahoma, which reached over 70% capacity by the end of 2021.

Volt

Volt (formerly RespondFlow) closed a \$2.5M seed round to enable solving compliance for the next generation of telecom.



Plant Seads moved product production to Oklahoma and landed its vertical gardening planters in 454 Walmart stores nationwide.



9B, a data technology consulting company, became one of the few Certified B Corps in the state of Oklahoma.



Boddle Learning and **QuirkChat** were selected as winners of Pharrell Williams' Black Ambition Initiative, receiving a total of \$300,000 in seed funding.



ACT House, a hub for cross-cultural collaboration, launched its Tulsa-based accelerator at the Incubator with 9 graduating companies from the first cohort and 4 going on to raise and close funding rounds.



36°N partnered with Devon Energy to launch the Innovation Scholarship for energy-tech startups driving the future of Tulsa's innovation and entrepreneurial ecosystem.
